

## Paris Agreement under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change

<b>Place of adoption of the Convention</b>	Paris – France
<b>Date of signature</b>	12 December 2015
<b>Date of entry into force</b>	4 November 2016
<b>Main objective</b>	<p>To confirm the global response to the threat posed by climate change through: (a) maintaining a global average temperature rise of well below 2° C above pre-industrial levels and to continue efforts to limit the temperature rise by not more than one-and-a-half degrees; (b) enhance capacity to adapt to the adverse effects of climate change by enhancing climate change resilience and consolidating low-carbon development in a way that does not threaten food production; (c) make financial flows consistent with a path leading to low-carbon development to cope with climate change.</p> <p>As in the Framework of the UNFCCC Convention and Kyoto Protocol, the Paris Agreement emphasizes the principle of "common but differentiated responsibilities" and takes into account the capacities of each Party by taking into consideration the different national circumstances.</p>
