Main objective	The Nagoya Protocol will create greater legal certainty and transparency for both providers and users of genetic resources by: Establishing more predictable conditions for access to genetic resources. Helping to ensure benefit-sharing when genetic resources leave the country providing the genetic resources By helping to ensure benefit-sharing, the Nagoya Protocol will create incentives to conserve and sustainably use genetic resources and therefore enhance the contribution of biodiversity to development and human well-being.
